ARS § 32-2321(F)(2) states "The certificate, license, qualification or registration may be suspended without a hearing if its holder fails within thirty days to: Pay civil penalties."

ARS § 32-2321(H) allows the SPCC to automatically revoke a license, qualification or certificate that is suspended under paragraph (F) without a hearing after one year of suspension.

1. A Bedder Pest Control Services - Case # 2000-189

The Commission voted to suspended on August 8, 2003 A. Bedder Pest Control Services Business License C 4104 B and Steven Barrett's Qualifying Party License 1318 B for failing to pay a \$1,200.00 balance of a civil penalty ordered in February 21, 2001.

However, after the Commission Meeting it was learned that Mr. Barrett paid by Money Order \$1,200.00 on August 5, 2003 the civil penalties to the Structural Pest Control Commission.

Staff's Recommendation: For the Commission to reconsider the suspension against A Bedder Pest Control Co., Inc., Business License # C 4104 B and Steven Barrett's Qualifying Party License 1318 B.

2. Ant Brian's Exterminating, Inc. - Case # 2002-084

The Commission suspended on August 8, 2003 Ant Brian's Exterminating, Inc. Business License C 5531 BC and Mr. Brian Oldham's Qualifying Party License # 2029 BC for failing to pay a \$1071.00 balance of civil penalty fees, TARF fees, late TARF fees, and insufficient check fees ordered in (per Consent Agreement) November 21, 2002.

On August 11, 2003, after the Commission meeting, Mr. Oldham paid by Cashier's Check \$1071.00 for civil penalty fees, TARF fees, late TARF fees, and insufficient check fees to the Structural Pest Control Commission.

Staff's Recommendation: For the Commission to review and consider lifting the suspension against Ant Brian's Exterminating, Inc., Business License # C 5531 BC and Brian Oldham's Qualifying Party License 2029 BC.
