**XII. For discussion, consideration and action: Reconsideration of denial to renew Gloria Kilian's Temporary Qualifying Party (Mr. Francis) .....TAB 58**

As an adjunct to the above matter, on July 8, 2003, the SPCC office received a Temporary Qualifying Party License Application from Dale Crawford (represented by attorney Richard Duffield), to be the temporary Q.P. for Kilian's Termite & Pest Control, if the Commission does not renew Mrs. Kilian's temporary Q.P. for this business licensee. Mr. Crawford holds an inactive Q.P. license. SPCC office staff discussed this matter with Mr. Duffield, who understands the legal requirements that must be met for the Commission to issue a Temporary Q.P. to Mr. Crawford (disassociation of Q.P., active in daily management, etc.); and that if a temporary Q.P. is not issued, then Kilian's Termite & Pest Control would not be permitted to conduct the business of structural pest control unless and until Mr. Crawford's Q.P. is activated for this business licensee (possibly on the August 2003 agenda).
