- XIV. For information, discussion and action (Ms. Gervase; Mr. Martin):
- B. Legislative changes needed in 2004 session:
 - 1. Include the State and Political Subdivisions in the definition of “person” to whom a license can be issued
 - 2. Restore the felony penalty for unlicensed activity
 - 3. Make all record-keeping requirements five years
 - 4. Change “certification” or “qualification” to “licensed”
 - 5. Clarify that a “fungi inspection report” is prepared in connection with the sale or refinancing of real property
 - 6. Make sure all references to the wood inspection report are consistent
 - 7. Clarify that the SPCC can establish offices (plural)
 - 8. Clarify that the Qualifying Party license application fee is for each application, not merely the initial application
 - 9. Delete reference to the Integrated Pest Management in Schools definition in the treatment proposal language

 - C. Integrated Pest Management guidelines for structural pest control practices at schools, due to the Governor and Legislature, before December 1, 2003. Commission approval required.
