**IV. Review, Discussion, and Possible Action on:**

- a) **OPM Move (Mr. Etheridge)**
- b) **HB2102 – Amends A.R.S. § 41-1080 regarding license eligibility to include Fingerprint Clearance Cards, requires photo ID issued by Government, and amends definition of “License”. (Mr. Jones)**
  1. **Passed Third Reading 4/12/2011**
- c) **HB2216 – restricts State Agencies from enacting or adopting standards or requirements by rule that are more stringent than a corresponding Federal Law. Enforced by GRRC and/or Governor’s Office. (Mr. Jones)**
  1. **No Information**
- c) **HB2312 & SB1194 – changes designation of A.R.S. title 32, chapter 22 to Structural Pest Management Regulation, moves oversight of OPM from Dept. of Administration to Dept. of Agriculture for two years, creates task force on regulation of structural pest management. (Mr. Jones)**
  1. **HB2312 – Passed Senate COW 4/6/2011 (Now: Agricultural Trust Funds)**
  2. **SB1194 – Transmitted to the Governor 4/5/2011**

- d) **SB1339 – repeals all State Agency Rules that have an impact on the private sector effective 12-31-2012, restricts State Agencies from adopting rules that impact the private sector, requires that any agency rule that has an impact on the private sector be enacted in statute, and defines private sector. (Mr. Jones)**

- 1. **Failed**

- e) **SB1458 – establishes reciprocity guidelines and establishes guidelines for Temporary Practice Permits which may be adopt by State Agencies (Mr. Jones)**

- 1. **Passed, House Military Affairs and Public Safety 3/23/2011**

- f) **SB1616 – makes necessary statutory and session law changes relating to general revenues to reconcile the FY2011-FY2012 state budget, including continuing the FY2010-FY2011 fee raising authority for the OPM. Limits these additional revenues to \$525,000.00. Exempts the fees from the rulemaking requirements until July 1, 2012.**
